



## UNC Health Championship Volunteer Committee Descriptions

Listed below are the areas in which we need help, and a brief description of the duties and responsibilities of each. If you would like more information on volunteering for the UNC Health Championship, contact [Cindy Hanson](#).

- Volunteers 17 and under are required to have a consent form signed by a parent/guardian.
- Volunteers 13 and under are required to be accompanied by an adult.
- Golf Cart and Motor Vehicle drivers must be 18 years or older with a valid driver's license.

### General Volunteer:

- Wednesday-Sunday (Activity Levels Vary, Note Any Restrictions When Registering)
- Want to volunteer but are unsure where you can be the most help? Sign up here!
- Volunteers will support other last-minute committees needs throughout the day.
- Other duties include helping Volunteer Services with lunch delivery, set-up/clean-up in Volunteer HQ, Fan-Fairway support and more.

### Caddie Hospitality:

- Monday-Sunday (Walking, Standing, Light Lifting)
- Meet and greet caddies and ensure hospitality area is a welcoming and relaxing environment.
- Assist with set-up and clean-up during breakfast and lunch. Restock snacks and beverages as needed and maintain a clean hospitality area free of debris.
- End of day – clean-up and set-up for next morning.

### Operations & Grounds:

- Advance Week Tournament Set-Up through Break-Down (Active, Heavy Lifting)
- Assist Operations & Grounds Team prior to tournament with grounds set-up, maintenance of structures, grounds, and venues during the tournament, and break-down after tournament.
- Responsibilities include, but not limited to set-up and break-down of; ropes & stakes, signage, fencing & screening, hospitality & spectator venues, scoreboards, clean-up and more.
- Volunteers are needed the week before, during, and after the tournament. Some light construction experience is preferred but not required.

### Crosswalk-On Course:

- Tuesday-Sunday (Standing, Walking, Some Sitting)
- Stationed at crosswalks on the course, at high traffic areas and at other locations throughout the course.



- Manage gallery traffic flow across crosswalks located on course. Volunteers will work closely with Marshal Committee to provide an environment that is safe and enjoyable for spectator flow as well as ensuring players are not distracted and play is not interrupted.

### **Hospitality:**

- Thursday-Sunday (Standing, Light Walking, Light Lifting)
- Stationed at VIP hospitality venues, you will provide a warm, welcoming VIP experience for credentialed spectators throughout their stay.
- Duties include meeting and greeting spectators at venue entrance, checking/scanning credentials, monitor snacks/drinks and supplies, and assist in keeping venue clean and free of debris, as well as daily set-up and clean-up.

### **Marshals:**

- Wednesday-Sunday (Standing, Walking, Some Sitting)
- Stationed inside the ropes at tees, greens, landing areas, and at hospitality venues. Work closely with Crosswalk Committee to help with gallery traffic control, ensuring play is maintained smoothly, safely, and continuously, limiting player distraction and play interruption.
- Duties also include, monitoring player's ball, assisting with locating, flagging, and protecting the ball when it falls outside the ropes or in the rough.

### **Player Services:**

- **Player & Caddie Registration:** Mon-Wed (Sitting, Some Standing)
  - Greet and check-in players and caddies arriving at your table in the clubhouse.
  - All items needed to check-in players and caddies will be provided by Tour Staff.
- **Clubhouse Dining Check-in** Mon-Sun (Sitting, Some Standing)
  - Stationed at entrance of dining area, you will meet, greet, and verify credentials before guest enters dining area in the clubhouse.
  - Responsibilities include using a list provided to keep an accurate account of guests entering dining area for breakfast and lunch.

### **Practice Facility:**

- Monday-Sunday (Moderate Walking, Moderate Lifting)
- Manage and support Driving Range, Chipping & Putting area operations.
- Aid Players and Caddies by assisting with spectator control, ball inventory and distribution, signage placement, etc. before, during and after play.



### **Product Supply & Distribution:**

- Monday-Sunday (Walking, Standing, Heavy Lifting/Strenuous Activity)
- Working as a team of 2 or more, you will be responsible for keeping product and supplies restocked throughout the day and secured after play.
- Duties include using a golf cart to assist with delivery of product and supplies to hospitality venues, Starting tents, tee boxes, Volunteer Headquarters, all hospitality venues, and all tournament and concession locations throughout the course.

### **Standard Bearer:**

- Friday PM-Sunday (Standing, Walking, Ability to Carry a Standard 18+ holes)
- The bearer will carry the standard for their group of pros while walking 18+ holes. (A standard is a hand-held scoreboard sign carried by a bearer that displays your group of players' names and tournament scores relative to par.)
- Friday PM and Saturday PM Set-up – Help with assembling the standards for Saturday and Sunday morning.
- Saturday-Sunday – Duties: Walk with your group of players and a walking scorer while carrying the standard for 18+ holes. In real time you will adjust your player's tournament scores on the standard while keeping the standard visible to the gallery.

### **Transportation:**

- Monday-Sunday (Light Walking, Some Standing)
- Driving shuttle carts and/or motor vehicles to help with scheduled volunteer transportation needs to on course and clubhouse locations.
- On-call shuttle carts or motor vehicle transport requests needed by Admissions, tournament officials/staff and Volunteer Services to on course and clubhouse locations.
- Tournament officials/staff may also request an unscheduled transportation need that may include an on/off course pickup or delivery.

### **Volunteer Services:**

- Prior to tournament, Monday-Sunday (Active, Some Lifting, Walking, Standing)
- Prior to tournament week if available, you will be able to help inventory, organize and participate in uniform distributions.
- During tournament week you will be stationed at Volunteer Headquarters. Duties include, meeting/greeting and managing credentialed volunteers through the daily check-in process, registering new volunteers, assist with schedule changes, and distribute uniforms.



- Help with breakfast and lunch set-up and break-down, assist Marshal and Crosswalk committees with lunch distribution, monitor and keep volunteer sitting areas clean and free from debris. Refill snacks and beverages as needed.
- End of day: clean-up and set-up for next morning.

### **Walking Scorer:**

- Wednesday-Sunday (Active, Walk 18+ holes, Standing, Some Sitting)
- ProAm Greenside Reporter (Wednesday Only) – Greenside Reporters are stationed on greens throughout the course and report scores via radio to Scoring Control.
- Tournament (Thursday-Sunday) – Walking Scorers are equipped with a scoring device and radio. You will walk 18 holes with a group of pros, keeping track of statistics and scores on a scoring device. Radios will be utilized when pros request a Rules Official, you or Scoring Control need to clarify/update a score, and/or when there is a need on the course that requires attention.
- Knowledge of golf is preferred. Training is mandatory.  
\*Those who work a Thursday or Friday shift will be given priority to work a weekend shift(s).\*
